2. maintenance /'mein.tə.nəns/ (n.): The work needed to keep something in good condition

Example: Regular *maintenance* of your car can prevent costly repairs in the future.

- massive / mæs.iv/ (adj.): Very large in size, amount, or degree
  Example: The massive elephant towered over the safari jeep, casting a large shadow.
- memorable / mem.ər.ə.bəl/ (adj.): Likely to be remembered or worth remembering Example: The fireworks display was so <u>memorable</u> that people talked about it for years.
- nutrient /'nu:.tri.ent/ (n.): A substance that organisms need to live and grow Example: Plants absorb <u>nutrients</u> from the soil to grow strong and healthy.

Example: From the hilltop, you could *overlook* the entire valley and its winding river.

- stable / ster.bəl/ (adj.): Not likely to change or fail; steady
  Example: The table was finally <u>stable</u> after he adjusted the legs properly.
- tendency / ten.dən.si/ (n.): A likelihood of behaving in a certain way
  Example: She has a <u>tendency</u> to forget her keys, so she always keeps a spare set.
- permanent / p3:r.mə.nənt/ (adj.): Lasting for a long time without change; enduring Example: The tattoo was a *permanent* reminder of her travels abroad.
- 10. persist /pə'sıst/ (v.): To continue to do something despite difficulties
  Example: If you *persist* with your studies, you'll see improvement over time.
- 11. postpone /poost poon/ (v.): To delay or put off an event to a later timeExample: The meeting was *postponed* due to the unexpected weather conditions.
